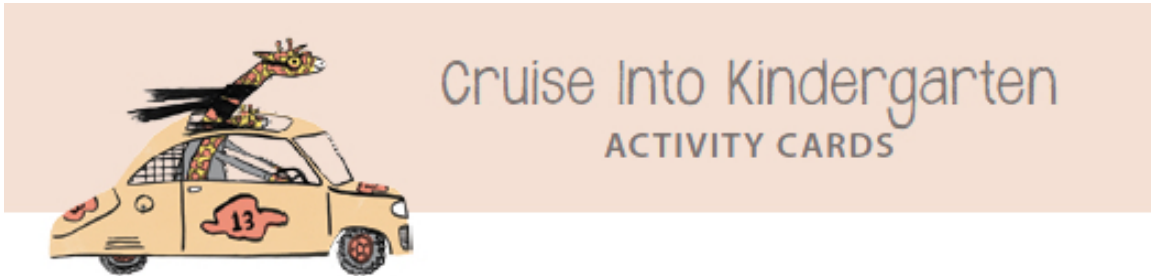


10 Ways to Use the Cruise into Kindergarten Activity Cards



1. Carry the cards with you on errands. You will always have a rhyme at the ready!
2. Make a "treasure chest" with the cards and a few of the books and materials inside ready to go!
3. Share copies of the cards with family and friends looking for gift ideas. Circle the books you think your child would like the best.
4. Take the cards with you on library visits, and have fun looking for some of the books together.
5. Start a "conversational word wall" with new vocabulary your child is learning. The more the words are used in conversation the better!
6. Create a "play and learn center" to go with a card's topic. Help your child create a colorful sign for the center.
7. Use the rhymes to start a poetry journal. Purchase a small notebook or make one together. Print one rhyme at a time for your child to illustrate.
8. Have a family performance night of the rhymes with your child as the star!
9. Record your child as he or she plays and explores. Share the video clip to celebrate your child's learning with family members!
10. Keep a "top ten" list of your child's favorite books and activities on the refrigerator.
